

Addendum# 2 TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

Drexel University

&

Delaware County Community College

This document constitutes an Addendum to the agreement between Drexel University and Delaware County Community College (DCCC) signed on 7/6/16.

1. Objective

The objective of this Addendum is to establish a new plan of study for the ADN-BSN Concurrent Enrollment Program and to provide additional opportunities for DCCC students to enroll in the program.

ELIGIBILITY (Changes and additions are bolded below)

For a student to be considered for participation in the ADN-BSN Concurrent Enrollment Program, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- All DCCC nursing program prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of a "C" or better and a minimum GPA of 2.5 must be attained.
- Students may enter the ADN-BSN Concurrent Enrollment Program cohort in Fall of Year 1 Nursing Course Work at DCCC **or cohort in Fall of Year 2 Nursing Course Work at DCCC.**
- **Pursuant to FERPA regulations, Drexel and DCCC will share the educational records of students enrolled in the concurrent program, for the purposes of each institutions' legitimate educational interests.**
- Students will have the ability to complete courses in the BSN program while completing the AD program. If the student does not adhere to the prescribed plan of study of the ADN-BSN Concurrent Enrollment Program, the curricular plan of study, financial aid, course availability, and/or progression may be adversely affected.

The summer after students have completed their ADN program, students will take the NCLEX exam. Students wishing to progress toward the BSN are required to complete all DCCC * prerequisite courses, all DCCC**co-requisite courses. Students must also have passed the NCLEX exam and have a GPA of 2.0 to enter the RN-BSN program at Drexel University. If additional ***BSN general education courses still need to be completed, students may work out a plan of study with their Drexel academic advisor to complete these requirements either at DCCC or at Drexel. To determine half-time and full-time status the conversion formulas are below:

The **Quarter to Semester conversion is 2/3 or (multiply by .667)**. We do not round up and all credits are administered on the .5 interval. Example a 3-credit quarter course would be 2 Semester credits. When applying the conversion, it is rounded down to the nearest .5 and not up to the whole credit. The **Semester to Quarter conversion would be 3/2 or (multiply by 1.5)**. We do not round up and all credits are administered on the .5 interval. Example a 3-credit semester course would be 4.5-quarter credits. When applying the conversion, it is rounded down to the nearest .5 and not up to the whole credit. **IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the parties have caused this Amendment to be executed by their authorized representatives.
